## A few St. Patrick's Day facts...

- St. Patrick's Day is an annual feast day celebrating the patron saint the day is named after.
- St. Patrick's Day is the national holiday of Ireland and is usually celebrated on March 17.
- St. Patrick's Day has become a popular holiday in the United States. People wear green and eat corned beef and cabbage.
- It is believed St. Patrick, a Roman-Britain-born Christian missionary, was born in the late fourth century and is credited with bringing Christianity to the Irish people.
- It is also believed St. Patrick drove all the snakes out of Ireland. However, post-glacial Ireland never actually had snakes. Many believe that the term "snakes" referred to the serpent symbolism of the Druids of that time and place. Today, there are no snakes to be found!
- Most people, whether they are Irish or not, wear green on this day. One of the Irish traditions is to pinch anyone who is not wearing green on St. Patrick's Day.
- Irish immigrants began observing the holiday in Boston in 1737 and the first St. Patrick's Day parade was held in New York City in 1766.
- Corned beef and cabbage are traditional foods eaten on this holiday.
- St. Patrick's Day has become a holiday all around the world and for one day out of the year

## Green Eggs and Ham

### Ingredients:

12 tart shells - frozen or homemade  
4 free-run eggs  
sea salt and black pepper to taste  
2 tablespoons milk or cream  
about 100g of thinly sliced ham,  
Irish bacon, regular bacon or prosciutto  
a few drops of green food colouring



Preparation time:  
Cooking time: 25 minutes  
Yield: 12

### Directions:

Pre-heat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).

Place frozen tart shells on cookie sheet or homemade pastry into muffin tins and set aside.

In a medium bowl, whisk the eggs, salt and pepper, food colouring and milk until completely blended and a shade of green the kids will get a kick out of.

When adding the ham or bacon you have a choice: either line the tart shell with the meat or chop and add a pinch of it to the bottom of the tart shell.

Portion the ham or bacon between the tart shells, then, using a ladle or jug, portion the egg mixture between the tart shells and finally top with a pinch of cheese. Try to leave some of the green egg mixture showing!

Bake for about 20 to 25 minutes or until the egg feels a bit spongy to the touch and the cheese is melted.

*Serve for breakfast, brunch or a snack. Delicious!*

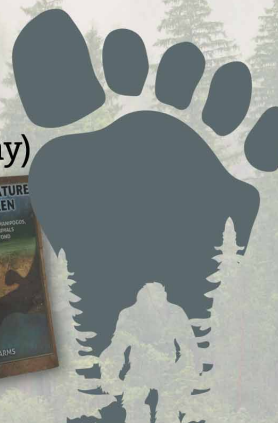

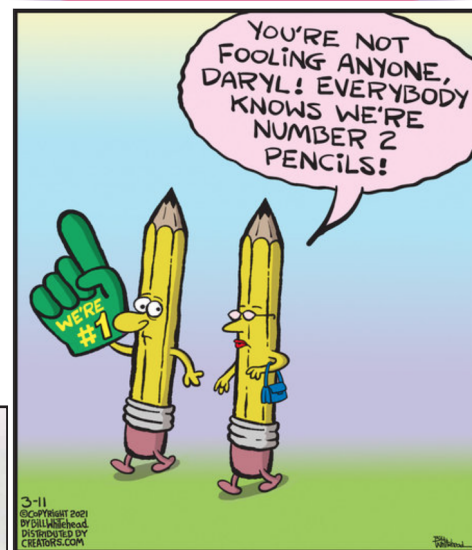
