





Homemade Marshmallow Pops Recipe

Homemade marshmallows are fun to eat on a stick or to stir into your favorite hot chocolate. Their melt-inyour-mouth texture appeals to the young and the young at heart.

Ingredients -1/2 c. water -1/2 c. cold water -1/4 tsp salt

-3 packets unflavored gelatin -1 tsp almond extract

-2 c. sugar
 -1/2 c. confectioners' sugar
 -1 c. light corn syrup
 -Lollipop sticks

Directions -1 c. light corn syrup

-In a large bowl, combine cold water and gelatin; set aside.

-Meanwhile, in a large heavy saucepan over medium heat, combine the sugar, corn syrup, water and salt. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. -Cover and cook for 2 minutes to dissolve sugar crystals; uncover and cook on mediumhigh heat, without stirring, until a candy thermometer reads 240° (soft-ball stage).

-Remove from the heat and gradually add to gelatin. Beat on medium speed for 14 minutes. Add extract; beat 1 minute longer. Meanwhile, sprinkle 2 table-spoons confectioners' sugar into a greased 13x9-in. pan.

-With greased hands, spread marshmallow mixture into prepared pan. Top with 2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar. Cover and cool at room temperature for 6 hours or overnight.

-Cut 15 snowflakes with a greased 2-1/2-in. snowflake-shaped cookie cutter; toss in remaining confectioners' sugar. If desired, gently press lollipop stick into each snowflake. Store in an airtight container in a cool, dry place.






