

## REGARDING SPECIAL SERVICE PROPOSAL- BY-LAW NO.03/21 FOR THE COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF WASTE AND RECYCLABLE MATERIAL FOR THE RM OF COLDWELL.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Coldwell has scheduled a public hearing at the Lundar Arena (Upstairs) on the 9th of April, 2021 at 7:00 pm to present the following special service proposal: To provide a Special Service levy for the collection and transportation of garbage and recycling from Residential and commercial properties within the municipality. Estimated costs for 2021 is \$174,580 and a per parcel rate will be \$215-225 single family, \$430-450 for a duplex, ect. Full description of Special service proposal is on the attached Schedule A.

A written objection may be filed with the Chief Administrative Officer, at Box 90 Lundar, MB R0C 1Y0 prior to the commencement of the hearing, At the hearing, Council will hear any potential taxpayer who wishes to make presentation, ask questions or register an objection to the special service proposal. Due to COVID restrictions please register with office if planning on attending.

All objections, written or verbal, must be filed prior to the adjournment of the hearing and must include the name, address and property description of the person filing the objection and the grounds of their objection.

## Stuffed Pepper Soup

Servings: 6  
 Calories: 261 • Fat: 5 g • Carb: 37.5 g • Fiber: 5 g • Protein: 17.6 g  
 • Sugar: 6 g Sodium: 606 g (without salt)

### INGREDIENTS

- 3 cups cooked brown rice
- 1 lb 95% lean ground beef
- 1/2 cup chopped green bell pepper
- 1/2 cup chopped red bell pepper
- 1 cup finely diced onion
- 3 cloves garlic, chopped
- 2 cans (14.5 oz each) cans petite diced tomatoes
- 1 3/4 cups tomato sauce
- 2 cups reduced sodium, fat-free chicken broth
- 1/2 tsp dried marjoram
- salt and fresh pepper to taste



### DIRECTIONS

In a large pot or dutch oven, brown ground meat on high heat and season with salt. Drain fat if any, reduce heat to medium-low, then add peppers, onions and garlic. Cook about 5 minutes on low heat.

Add tomatoes, tomato sauce, chicken broth, marjoram and season with salt and pepper to taste. Cover and simmer on low heat for 30 minutes. Serve about 1 1/3 cups of soup in each bowl and top with 1/2 cup cooked brown rice. Makes about 9 1/2 cups.



### INGREDIENTS

- Green food color

- 3 green-colored sour candies, separated into strips
- Construction paper

### DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 325°F. Grease 1 1/2-quart ovenproof bowl (8 inches across top) with shortening; coat with flour (do not use cooking spray). Lightly grease 3 muffin cups in regular-size muffin pan.
2. Make cake batter as directed on box. Pour cake batter in 3 muffin cups, filling two-thirds full. Pour remaining batter into 1 1/2-quart bowl.
3. Bake cupcakes 17 to 21 minutes, bowl 47 to 53 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes. Remove cakes from muffin cups and bowl; place rounded sides up on cooling racks. Cool completely, about 1 hour. If necessary, cut off rounded tops of cakes.
4. Spoon frosting into large bowl. Add red food color to make desired pink color. Place bowl cake on tray cut side down; spread 1/3 cup frosting over cake. Use frosting to adhere cupcakes to bowl cake for feet and bunny tail. Use toothpicks if necessary. Place marshmallow halves, cut sides down, on tops of 2 cupcakes to make heels of feet. Spread thin layer of frosting over side and top of cake to seal in crumbs. Freeze cake 30 to 45 minutes to set frosting.
5. Spread remaining frosting over cake. Sprinkle with 2 cups of the coconut; press gently to adhere. Shake 1 cup coconut and 3 drops green food color in tightly covered jar until evenly tinted. Surround bunny with tinted coconut. Use rolling pin to press strawberry candies into 2 large rectangles. Cut 2 large ovals and 6 small circles out of candy. Press onto bottoms of bunny feet, using frosting if needed.
6. Roll up fruit snack to make carrot shapes. Cut green sour candies in half crosswise; press into large end of each carrot to make greens on carrot. Cut ears from construction paper; wrap ends that will be inserted into cake with plastic food wrap. Insert into cake. Remove ears, plastic wrap and toothpicks before serving. Store loosely covered.



The Building Inspector is responsible for buildings under Part 9 of the National Building Code (2010). This position consists of flexible hours and may require more time in the busy construction season and less during the winter months when there is a lull in development, half time position. This position also requires a sound knowledge of the National Building Code (2010), National Plumbing Code and Municipal Zoning By-laws and a sound understanding of construction best practices.
