The first total lunar eclipse of 2022 illuminated skies over Canada Sunday night. Were you lucky enough to see it?

The Earth, Moon, and Sun lined up to produce a total lunar eclipse. The Full Moon first dims, then turns a dusky red. Then it leaves the red colour behind and grows brighter until the eclipse ends.


For the second year in a row, we experienced a Blood Flower Moon, where the Moon turns red as it passes straight through Earth's shadow.

If you missed the eclipse entirely, don't worry. There's another chance to see one in early November 2022.

STRAWBERRY RHUBARB SQUARES

Ingredients

- 1 cup rolled oats - (not quick-cooking)
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 tps salt
- 1/2 cup (1 stick) unsalted butter - melted
- 1 cup diced rhubarb - (2-3 stalks)
- 1 cup diced fresh strawberries
- 2 tbsps granulated sugar
- 1 tbsps lemon juice
- 2 tps cornstarch



Instructions

- Heat oven to 375 degrees F. Line the bottom of an 8x8-inch baking pan with parchment paper. Spray lightly with baking spray. Set aside.
- In a bowl, mix together the oats, flour, brown sugar, and salt. Pour the melted butter over this mixture and stir until clumps form. Set aside 1/2 cup of this mixture for the crumb topping. Press the remaining mixture evenly into the bottom of the prepared pan.
- In another bowl, mix together the rhubarb, strawberries, sugar, lemon juice, and cornstarch. Spread this mixture evenly on top of the prepared crust. Scatter the reserved flour mixture over the fruit to make a crumb topping. Bake 30-35 minutes or until the fruit is bubbly and the top "crust" is golden.
- Allow the bars to cool completely before slicing and serving. Begin by heating your oven to 375 degrees F. Line the bottom of an 8x8-inch baking pan with parchment paper. Spray lightly with baking spray. Set aside.

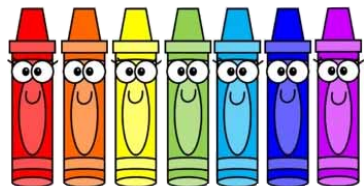
DID YOU KNOW?

A truel is a three-person expansion of a duel, in which each of the truelists can attempt to survive by shooting at opponents in order to eliminate them.

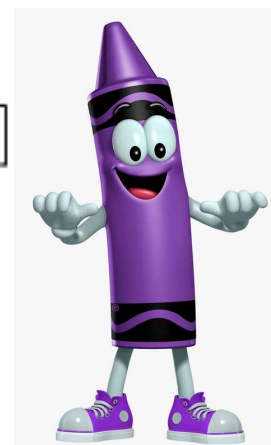
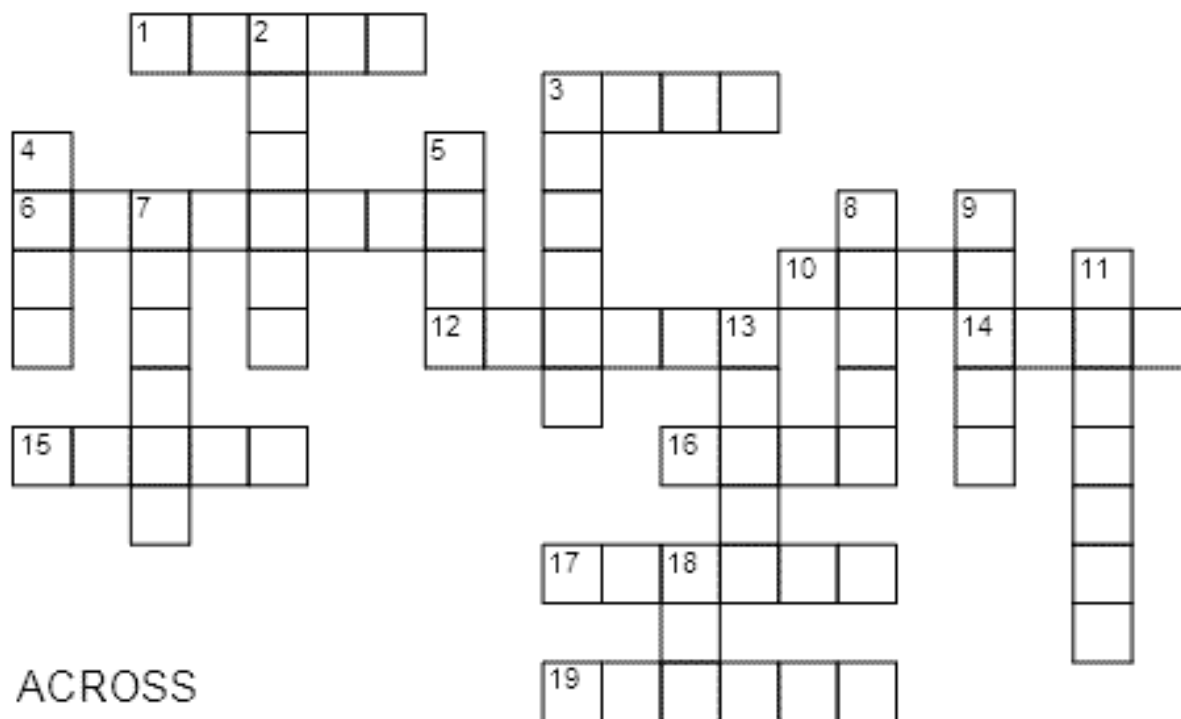
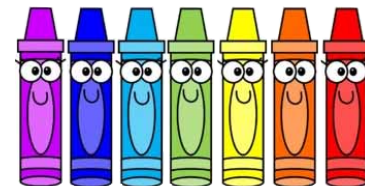

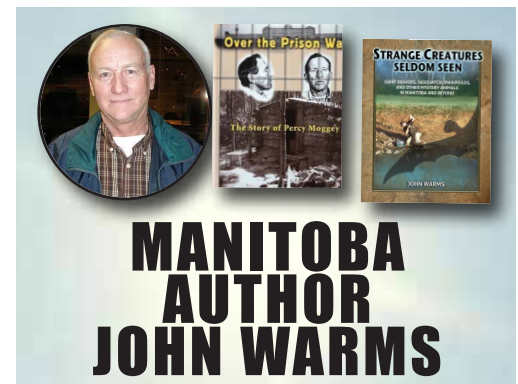
